WARNING LAYING INSTRUCTIONS

LAYING

- It is absolutely essential to remove any remains of the laying material (cements, grouting...) with a non-abrasive sponge and with plenty of water, avoiding rubbing on the tiles.
- It is very important to carry out this operation before any remains are dry. In case it occurs, the tile must be removed and replaced, because cement absorption softens the enamel and it cannot be recovered.
- It is important to avoid scratches on the tiles when taking the sheets out of the cartons and when damping and cleaning them. These tiles are very sensitive to absorption products (such as cement, acids and scratching)

MAINTENANCE

- Do not use powder detergents, acid or alkaline solutions or abrasive scourers. You only need a damp cloth and a neutral soap solution.
